



## ***District/Authority Scholarship Notification***

You have been named by your school district or the Federation of Independent School Associations (FISA) as a **conditional winner** of a District/Authority Scholarship, valued at \$1,250, for the 2018/2019 school year.

Winners must be Canadian citizens or Permanent Residents at the time of registration in the 2018/2019 school year and fulfill BC graduation requirements by August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019.

After this deadline, you will be notified, and your voucher will be issued once the Ministry of Education confirms you have met the eligibility requirements for the scholarship. Starting in October, you can also check to see if you have been issued a voucher by logging into the **Student Transcript Service** at <https://www2.gov.bc.ca/gov/content/education-training/k-12/support/transcripts-and-certificates>.

You can redeem a voucher when you're registered and attending a designated post-secondary institution or an authorized trades training provider in B.C. and have paid tuition equal to or greater than the amount of the voucher.

You have five years to redeem the scholarship. Check the expiry date on your voucher.
