We spent most of the money that we had last year. There will be a new grant of about \$2500 coming shortly.

Principal’s Report:

There is an enrolment of 161 students. There are more students starting out with Glacier View this September, than last year. Since August 19, Murray has registered 38 students.

Glacier View staffing is very much the same as last year. There is a new ISW, Sara O’Malley and a new EA, Graham Green.

Mental Health Curriculum will be taught by Stephen Hoelzley this year. Kelsea Lochhead and Lindsay Skelding will continue delivering the sexual health curriculum.

There are new computers in classrooms and there are additional ones as well. Teachers now have new laptops.

The Foods Program is up and running again this year. There is an AM class and a PM class. The first class was today. Students cook for the first half of the class and they do some online computer work for the second half. The classes are full and there is a waitlist.

The school garden needs some attention. Paul Bozenich has retired from his position. The school has a sustainability rep who will be attending meetings. It is hoped that the garden can be improved this year.

We have lost some volunteers this year: Cassia and Reuben from Youth Unlimited. Reuben is overseas and he may return later in the year. Mary, a retired RCMP officer, will be back at Glacier View to help out this year as a volunteer.

There is some new fitness equipment in the gym that came from Cumberland community school.

Last year there were 32 grads, this was by far the largest grad class that Glacier View has had. This year the preliminary list for potential graduates is at 38 students.

Connie has put forward a motion to allocate some seed money towards the next Funday. This motion has been passed.
