There is \$300 in the discretionary account and \$2400 in the gaming account. There has been a request for \$500 towards screen printing set-up and this request has been approved.

Principal’s Report:

Audit: This was concluded last week. This went very well and the audit team was happy with the documentation and services that were provided to students at Glacier View.

Glacier View registered their 60th student so far this year. 10 new students were registered during the last week and there are 3 more registrations next week.

Expenses were higher than expected for the kitchen renovations and more time is needed to gather funds for this project. The school will be maintaining high quality plans and is hoping to have the kitchen ready for September 2018.

Wellness centre update: The fifth in a series of seminars offered in the wellness centre was held. The topic was “PTSD: Trauma and Informed practice”.

One of our new teachers, Jenne Riske has went on maternity leave as she has adopted a 16 month old boy. Her last day was last Friday. A teacher has to be hired to fill this position.

Paul Bozenich is off this week for a hernia operation. He is scheduled to return part-time next week. Paul is scheduled to retire at the end of March.

FESL (framework to enhance student learning): We have continued to work on encouraging our students to embrace a growth mindset in addition to working on improving student attendance. Attendance is displayed in classrooms bi-monthly via coloured graphs and students are encouraged to monitor these. Each month, the names of students with excellent attendance are displayed. In addition to this, a monthly award and pizza lunch is given to the class with the

best attendance. Growth mindset posters are on display in classrooms and teachers are encouraging their students to develop new ways of thinking in accordance with a growth mindset.

Our volunteer Cassia has been coming in 4 days a week and she has helped with many projects around the school including being a “success mentor” to support students.
