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Dual Credit Program Partnership with NIC - Information Session

Parents/guardians and students are invited to an information session to learn about the Dual Course Credit Academic program, an educational experience in partnership with North Island College (NIC).

Dual credit courses are a great way for Grade 11 or 12 students to transition from high school to post-secondary education. The program allows youth to spend a portion of their second semester completing college courses or pursuing a certificate program at NIC.

With dual credit courses, students can simultaneously earn high school graduation credits in any elective course such as Biology 12, and NIC college credits. Comox Valley Schools covers the cost of the tuition. Students are only required to pay for other costs associated with a course or certificate program.

The following courses/programs are offered in the Dual Credit program for the 2019-2020 school year:

- English 115 and 120
- Psychology 130 and 131
- Business 162
- Health Care Assistant program (7-month program)
- Early Childhood Care & Education Certificate program (10-month program)

Interested students are encouraged to start the NIC application process now to ensure they will receive their prerequisite course, English 12, in the first semester at secondary school.
