

## **ADMISSION TO THE PRIMARY PROGRAM**

### **Procedure**

1. If a child has been in attendance in a regular school system at either the Kindergarten or Grade 1 level and subsequently transfers to this area, he or she may be enrolled in the appropriate grade even though he or she does not comply with the age requirements of Section 3(1)(a) of the *School Act*, providing that a certificate or letter from the former District Superintendent is presented confirming the fact that the student had completed the year's work or was currently enrolled in the Kindergarten or Grade 1 program.
