POSITION: COMMUNITY INTEGRATION SUPPORT WORKER

RESPONSIBILITIES: Under the supervision of the École Edward Schreyer School Student Support Services team, you will provide service to students enrolled at the Alternative Learning Program, Beausejour, Manitoba such as:

- Provide one to one and group support to youth with environmental and behavioural challenges
- Support outcomes, strategies and activities in the off campus alternative learning classroom
- Formulate goals, action plans and strategies together with your clients and their caregivers
- Through community based recreational activities, support youth, using coaching, modeling and supportive strategies, to develop life skills, age and ability-appropriate independence and inclusion in the community
- As resource, advocate, role-model and community liaison, connect with external agencies as part of an integrated team
- Establish relationships with youth to ensure they are connected to longer term community resources.
- Engage with and encourage youth to participate in pro-social activities when possible arranging for access to youth specific activities and workshops.
- Attend community meetings and appointments with youth when required in order to address their specific needs.
- Obtain professional learning and training as required by the school and school division.
- Provide documentation when required.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A Bachelors' Degree in a related field and/or previous experience in related social service roles.
- Satisfactory Child and Adult Abuse Registry check, Criminal Record Check (vulnerable sector search) and a satisfactory Driver's Abstract and license.
- Certification of First Aid Level 1 – Emergency.
- The ability to attend work regularly as scheduled or requested.
- Demonstrated language, writing, comprehension skills.
- Demonstrate cultural knowledge competence and participate in agency training for development.
