



## 2018 Election - School Trustee Sunrise School Division Voter Information

### Who is eligible to vote for a trustee?

- A Canadian Citizen
- 18 years or older on Election Day, October 24, 2018
- A *resident* of the Sunrise School Division Ward for at least six months prior to election day

### Resident Voters

- A person is a resident of the place where he/she ordinarily resides, and to which he/she intends to return when away from it.
- A person may be a resident of only one place at a time.
- A person does not change residence until he/she has a new residence.

### Did You Know?

A person who leaves a municipality for temporary reasons is still considered a resident voter. For example, a student attending university outside the municipality, but who intends to return home after the term ends, is considered a resident voter.

Persons with no fixed address may vote in a municipal or school division election. If the person has no ordinary residence in the local authority (Sunrise School Division Ward), they are deemed to reside at the shelter, hostel or other similar institution that most frequently provides lodging, food, or other social services. The SEO may allow the voter to swear an oath in order to vote.

### Voters List

The Voters List in the Sunrise School Division is open for changes or revisions in accordance with Section 36 of *The Municipal Councils and School Boards Elections Act*.

All changes to the Voters List must be completed on or before September 18, 2018. Non-resident land owners may not vote for a School Trustee.
