1. Will bussing be provided with grandfathered cross boundaries?
We do not provide bussing for cross boundary students. They would be able to apply to ride as a courtesy rider, but only if there is room.
2. Why can't we purchase the Oyster River school and change the School District boundary?
This is under the jurisdiction of the Ministry.
3. Are budget restrictions coming into play?
Any costs off adding additional spaces in overcrowded schools would be charged to local capital. The ministry will not help offset these costs if we have space in our district at other schools.
4. If you fix elementary does it help high schools?
High school numbers can be adjusted (helped) if we change boundaries or feeder school locations.
5. Have you considered the impact of moving Navigate?
We are considering all the ideas that have been presented through the spring consultations, fall consultations and online survey.

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6. Where does the enrolment of FAE come from?

The enrolment from FAE comes from across our school district. There is no geographical boundary.

7. Can Queneesh borders move to accommodate Huband students?

Anything is possible. We will look at all suggestions and run the numbers to see if it makes sense.

8. What is the budget?

There is no set budget. We will consider budget as we look at all the options as some ideas will cost more than others.
