

March 16, 2020 **NO ACCESS TO SCHOOLS during a SCHOOL CLOSURE**

Dear Parents & Staff:

On March 15, 2020, schools across the province were closed by a provincial Order in Council. While families may have personal belongings in schools, at this time you will not be able to access them. Your family's personal belongings are safe and secure in the school.

If your child left perishable items in a school locker, please email the school and let the school know. The school staff are working Monday and will be able to assist in removing any perishable items.

If your child left electronics in the school, they will be stored in their existing location. Once we receive direction, we will provide you with more information.

If you come to the school, the doors of the school will be locked and you will be prohibited from coming in. Classes across the province are cancelled until further notice. Students are expected to stay home.

Every school will hold a staff meeting at 9 AM, where protocols and expectations will be reviewed. Teachers and other school staff have work to do. Everyone's work will be directed to support student learning and ensure the organization can function.

Please have faith that we will do our best to support families.
