Advance voting to be concluded by October 21, 2018
- October 24** 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. **ELECTION DAY**
- October 25** Announcement of official results

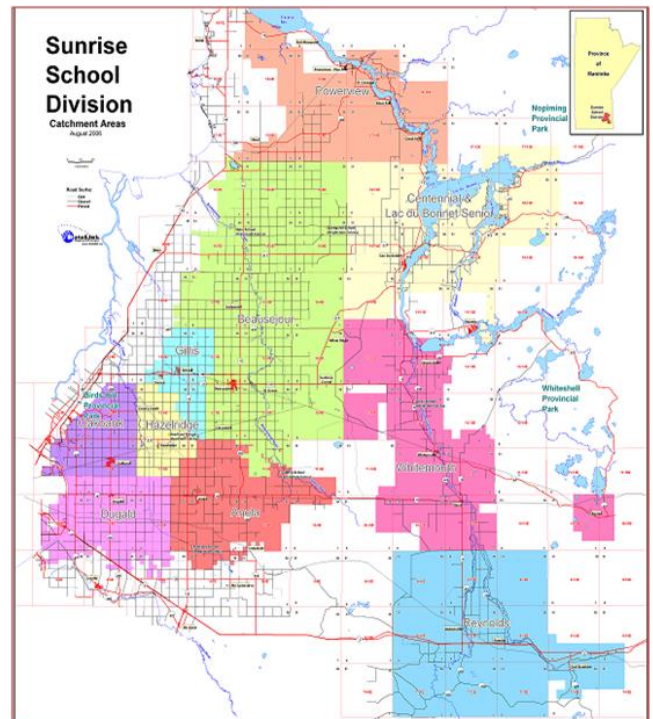
## 2018 Election - School Trustee Sunrise School Division Voter and Candidate Information

## 2018 Election - School Trustee Sunrise School Division Candidate Information

### Persons eligible to be a candidate must be:

- A Canadian citizen
- 18 years old or older on Election Day, October 24, 2018
- A resident in the Sunrise School Division since April 24, 2018
- Not be disqualified by law, or any other provision of *The Public Schools Act*

No employee or pupil in regular attendance at school shall be a School Trustee of the School Division of which he/she is an employee or pupil.

### Note:

- Candidates for School Trustee do not have to reside in the Ward of the Sunrise School Division in which they are seeking election, but must be a resident elector of that School Division.

### The Nomination Process

In this process, candidates file *Nomination Papers* which provide evidence of support from eligible voters of the ward in which they are seeking election.

- As of September 18, 2018 a candidate's nomination papers must be signed by the lesser of 25 voters whose names appear on the voters list for the ward, or 1% of the total number of voters whose name appears on the voters list for the ward.

Individuals seeking election may obtain a Nomination Package from the Sunrise School Division Business Centre, 75-Fifth Street South, Beausejour or from the Secretary-Treasurer/Senior Election Official, [SEO@sunrisesd.ca](mailto:SEO@sunrisesd.ca)

Nomination papers will be accepted during regular hours (9:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.) at the Sunrise School Division Business Centre by appointment – September 12, 2018 to September 18, 2018. (Nominations close September 18)

Contributions made to a candidate for School Trustee are not tax-deductible for the contributor. Funds expended on the election of a candidate are not tax-deductible.

## 2018 Election - School Trustee Sunrise School Division Voter Information

### Who is eligible to vote for a trustee?

- A Canadian Citizen
- 18 years or older on Election Day, October 24, 2018
- A *resident* of the Sunrise School Division Ward for at least six months prior to election day

### Resident Voters

- A person is a resident of the place where he/she ordinarily resides, and to which he/she intends to return when away from it.
- A person may be a resident of only one place at a time.
- A person does not change residence until he/she has a new residence.

### Did You Know?

A person who leaves a municipality for temporary reasons is still considered a resident voter. For example, a student attending university outside the municipality, but who intends to return home after the term ends, is considered a resident voter.

Persons with no fixed address may vote in a municipal or school division election. If the person has no ordinary residence in the local authority (Sunrise School Division Ward), they are deemed to reside at the shelter, hostel or other similar institution that most frequently provides lodging, food, or other social services. The SEO may allow the voter to swear an oath in order to vote.

### Voters List

The Voters List in the Sunrise School Division is open for changes or revisions in accordance with Section 36 of *The Municipal Councils and School Boards Elections Act*.

Any person wishing to have his/her name added to the Sunrise School Division Voters List, may do so by contacting [SEO@sunrisesd.ca](mailto:SEO@sunrisesd.ca) or call 204-268-6514.

All changes to the Voters List must be completed on or before September 18, 2018.

Non-resident land owners may not vote for a School Trustee.

Sunrise School Division  
Application for a Personal Security  
Certificate and Identification Number**

A person may apply in writing to the SEO no later than September 18, 2018 to have his/her name and address obscured from the Voters List. A person whose name has been obscured will receive a Personal Security Certificate and Identification Number.

The application may be submitted in person, by mail or fax and must include your name, address, and proof of identity, such as:

- (a) an official document issued by a federal, provincial, or municipal government that includes the voter's name, address and photograph (driver's license, passport), or
- (b) at least two other documents that provide evidence of the person

You must fill out an application to vote by sealed envelope, and provide a Personal Security Certificate with the application. Contact [SEO@sunrisesd.ca](mailto:SEO@sunrisesd.ca) for more information.

September 26, 2018 - First day to *apply in-person* to vote by sealed envelope  
October 21, 2018 - Last day to *apply in-person* to vote by sealed envelope
