## Could We Help?

If you know or suspect your teen to have **two or more** of the following behaviours, your child could be making risky decisions that will seriously affect their future:

- ✚ Regular use of alcohol or drugs
- ✚ Poor or no school attendance
- ✚ Poor academic achievement
- ✚ Involvement with the law/criminal history
- ✚ Sexually promiscuous behaviour
- ✚ Poor family relations
- ✚ Mental health issues

Our goal is to prevent further involvement in problem behaviour by coordinating information sharing and resources to help you find the best solutions for your child's issues.

The D.A.R.T. Program and its community partners look beyond the behaviours to find out what is causing the youth to act in a risky way. We then figure out how to resolve these issues so that the youth can move forward in a positive, healthy manner.
