

Kindergarten Supply List 2019-2020

School Supply Fee of **\$25.00** to cover the cost of basic school supplies such as pencils, crayons, erasers, notebooks, and glue as well as a **\$20.00** general fee to cover costs for classroom/school celebrations for a total of **\$45.00**. Please bring the **\$45.00** to your child's Kindergarten interview in the labeled envelope that has been provided in this Kindergarten package. Cheques are to be made payable to Gilbert Plains Elementary School.

Please bring the **\$45.00** to school on the first day of classes. Cheques are to be made payable to Gilbert Plains Elementary School.

- 1 plastic pencil box *** Please note: Do not get a "cloth" one. The snaps and/or zippers often break and the students are not able to "open it up" to see their supplies i.e.: crayons which they end up dumping inside because the paper crayon boxes break. (Grade Two students do not need to purchase another pencil box. I have kept this past year's box.)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex *** A few boxes will be set around the room at a time to be shared communally.
- 1 backpack for carrying belongings to and from school
- 1 lunch kit *** You may also choose to supply a water bottle for your child to keep at his/her cubby. Your child will be able to fill it at the fountain and he/she will be encouraged to take it home the end of each week to be washed.
- 1 pair of supportive runners for Phys. Ed., preferably **not** flat bottomed aka skateboarding shoes. Avoid runners with zippers and (black) soles that mark floors. If you are going to send runners with shoelaces, please practice tying shoelaces over the summer.
- 1 extra set of clothing, including underwear, in a clearly labeled bag. These will be kept at the cubbies and sent home to be washed if used. Please kindly return articles of clothing to replace soiled items ASAP.

Dear Parents,

A combined Home Economics - Industrial Arts course is part of the Grade 7 & 8 program in the Grandview and Gilbert Plains Schools. Students, in co-ed classes, take half a year of Home Economics and half a year of Industrial Arts skills. In Grade 9 students may choose to take either Home Economics or Industrial Arts for the entire year to receive a half-credit for their high school program.

The aim of the Home Economics program is to introduce basic sewing skills, reinforce clothing care, introduce and expand cooking skills and develop consumer awareness.
